



Public Safety Advisory Committee Meeting February 21st, 2013

Carol Colleen called the meeting to order at about 6:00 pm.

Nomination for Chair and Vice Chair were open. Ted Kotsakis was nominated for Chair and Cerissa Farrington was nominated for Vice Chair. It was a unanimous vote to approve.

November 29th, 2012 Minutes were approved unanimously.

There was no public comment.

Staffing Committee gave an update with new figures. It was discussed using Red Light funds to possibly fund one officer and reduce the revenue enhancement proposal fee.

The conclusion of the Staffing committee discussion was to meet again with Chief Johnson, Lesa Folger and Samantha Nelson and bring more information back to the next PSAC meeting.

The Chief updated the PSAC group with the following information:

Red Light Camera update. The Red Light Camera program continues to be successful. In a zip code study there has been a 35% decrease in citations in the 97024 zip code and there has been only 1 rear end collision at that intersection since the cameras have been installed.

Gresham Police Department has given us a hand me down Gang car. It couldn't have come at a better time because our EMGET car was on its last leg.

There will be a goal setting session next week. Some of the top priorities are:

1. Each officer to have their own rifle.
2. Putting a rifle at the middle school in a safe.

The grant for the Crime Analyst position that we had last year with Troutdale PD was coming close to ending. The monies have been approved by the Federal Government to be spent on technology for Taser Cameras and Body Cameras.

We have been granted an extension for Accreditation to June 30, 2013.

Congratulations to Officer Gerkman! He is a new daddy.

Anyone interested in taking a tour of our parks on the Rhino please contact Chief Johnson.

Budget starts next week. Our patrol cars are getting old and in need of repairs. The Police Department will be coming to the Budget committee asking to buy or lease some new vehicles. There is approximately \$90,000 in the equipment vehicle replacement fund.

The Chief will be asking PSAC to put a committee together for National Night Out.

Awards Program: There was a brief discussion about the awards program. The Police Department would like to do an afternoon awards recognition sometime in May possibly during Police Officer Week.




