



PSAC MEETING MINUTES

September 5, 2017

Chief's Report:

No Chief's report due to Chief being assigned to working Eagle Creek Fire response command.

Old Business:

Mr. Williams raised a question/concern about the front counter service at the PD office at City Hall (Chief will address this with PSAC at next meeting).

Chair Marker suggested that PSAC sponsor a survey of City residents a year into the consolidation contract to see how policing services are doing under the Sheriff's Office. Chair Marker also suggested a notice be given to residents six months prior to the survey to prepare people to be able to give their thoughts and impressions. Councilor Forsythe suggested that the survey be accompanied with statistics.

Mr. Young suggested to have Council Liaison report to the city council that PSAC work with staff in one year to send out a satisfaction survey to the community with six months' notice. Chair Marker made motion, Mr. Hill seconded and it was unanimously passed.

Council Work Plan: There is good progress on five items. We will continue with on-going efforts.

PSAC wants to have another community preparedness seminar in November so as not to lose momentum. Councilor Forsythe will work with Chief and Alice Busch of Emergency Management to identify date and tentative agenda and report to Board in September.

PSAC would like to identify a schedule for semi-annual seminars for 2018.

New Business:

The PSAC discussed concerns at Fairview Oaks/Woods will be brought to the Chief.

Mr. Young reported that Home forward is working with city to re-establish quarterly meetings. This will include connecting management to the neighborhood watch. A deputy has been assigned to work with neighborhood watch and management
