At their June 5 business meeting, the Fairview City Council adopted the approved budget for Fiscal Year 2019-2020, in the total amount of \$29,359,715. The budget reflects the City Council goals and direction as it relates to maintaining the long-term financial health and stability of the City's General Fund and reserves, and continues the delivery of high-quality services for the Fairview Community.

When using this service, an MCSO Deputy will check up on your house while you are gone and make sure everything is ok.



MCSO is continuing to see a slew of attempted fraud via emails and spam phone calls. Please remember that MCSO does not solicit money for arrest warrants, missed jury duty, or unpaid traffic/parking tickets by phone. Do not give your personal/financial information to someone posing on the phone as an MCSO deputy who asks for money, gift cards, or other items of value. If you have a question about the validity of a call, please call 503-988-7300 and ask to speak with a Patrol Deputy. We NEVER ask for money over the phone.
