New PSU Hatfield Resident Fellow

The US 2020 Census is important to our community. We have joined forces with the city of Wood Village to create a coordinated campaign to count every resident. To help us prepare, we have hired Cristal Otero, a Portland State University 2019-2020 Hatfield Resident Fellow. Cristal comes to us from Multnomah County's Joint Offices of Homeless Services. Cristal will lead Fairview and Wood Village to convene a local 2020 Census Complete Count Committee. Anticipate hearing from Cristal over the next several weeks as she reaches out to community leaders regarding census planning.
