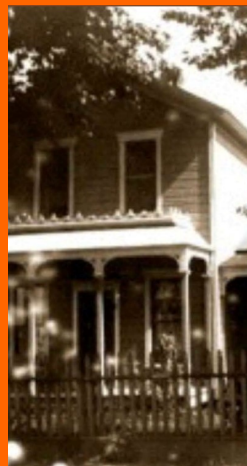

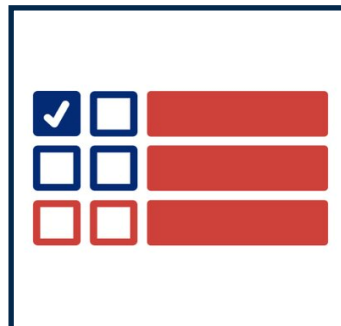

- your full bank or credit card account numbers
