**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF FAIRVIEW ADOPTING THE
CITY OF FAIRVIEW HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN**

WHEREAS, the City of Fairview is potentially subject to many different types of natural disasters and emergencies, and

WHEREAS, Chapter 2.40 of the Fairview Municipal Code provides for the adoption of an Emergency Management and Operations Plan to minimize injury to persons and property and to preserve the established civil authority in the event that a state of emergency exists within the city (the “Emergency Operations Plan”); and

WHEREAS, the Fairview City Council set a Council goal to update the City’s current Emergency Operations Plan; and

WHEREAS, on September 15, 2010, the Fairview City Council adopted Resolution 26-2010, which adopted a complete rewrite of the City’s Emergency Operations Plan; and

WHEREAS, a major component of the City’s Emergency Management Program is planning for potential natural disasters and emergencies; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fairview Hazard Mitigation Plan was developed in part with a FEMA Flood Mitigation Assistance Planning grant to Multnomah County for the development of flood hazard mitigation plans for the cities of Troutdale, Fairview and Wood Village. The Hazard Mitigation Plan for the City of Fairview covers each of the major natural hazards that pose risks to the City; and

WHEREAS, the primary objectives of this Mitigation Plan are to reduce the negative impacts of future disasters on the community, to save lives and reduce injuries, minimize damage to buildings and infrastructure (especially critical facilities) and minimize economic losses; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Homeland Security’s Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has completed the required pre-adoption review of the Hazard Mitigation Plan and has committed to approve the plan upon receipt of adoption of this resolution by the Fairview City Council; and

WHEREAS, once FEMA adopts the Hazard Mitigation Plan, the City of Fairview will become eligible for mitigation project grants from FEMA.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAIRVIEW AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City of Fairview Hazard Mitigation Plan dated January 5, 2011, which is attached to the Staff report as exhibit “A”, is hereby adopted.

Section 2. This resolution is and shall be effective from and after its passage by the City Council.


