1. Call to order

Chair Kaufman called the meeting to order at 6:00pm.

2. Discussion Items not on the Agenda

Chair Kaufman inquired if any person wished to speak on a non agenda item; as no one requested to speak, moved to approval of minutes.

3. Review & Adopt Minutes

June 9, 2011 approved as written by consensus.

4. Election of Vice Chair

Committee Member Dehle nominated Committee Member Taylor and Committee Member Cooper seconded. Committee Member Taylor was elected Vice Chair by consensus.

5. Park Patrol Discussion and Park Patrol Vehicle

Police Chief Ken Johnson announced the park patrol vehicle had been equipped and a training program for vehicle users had been implemented. Staff believed increased police presence and visibility in the parks would deter unwanted behaviors. Public response had been positive.

6. Summary of City Council Pocket Park Discussion

Senior Planner Nesbitt presented Council's feedback from their pocket park discussion. They approved removing Greenwich Park from the park inventory and dedicating it as ROW and discussed options for handling the other pocket parks. City Administrator Joseph Gall commented reductions in resources necessitated reviewing how the city maintained its parks. Staff requested Council provide clear guidelines as to how they want PRAC and staff to proceed.


7. Salish Ponds Project Update
