

**RESOLUTION**  
**(21-2011)**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF FAIRVIEW, OREGON  
STATING THE CITY'S QUALIFICATIONS FOR STATE SHARED REVENUE FUNDS**

**WHEREAS**, ORS 221.760 provides as follows:

Section 1. The officer responsible for disbursing funds to cities under ORS 323.455, 366.785 and 366.820 and 471.805 shall, in the case of a city located within a county having more than 100,000 inhabitants according to the most recent federal decennial census, distribute such funds only if the city provides four or more of the following services:

- 1) Police protection
- 2) Fire protection
- 3) Street construction, maintenance and lighting
- 4) Sanitary sewer
- 5) Storm sewers
- 6) Planning, zoning and subdivision control
- 7) One or more utility services, and

**WHEREAS**, city officials recognize the desirability of assisting the state officer responsible for determining the eligibility of cities to receive such funds in accordance with ORS 221.760,


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAIRVIEW AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1:** The City of Fairview hereby certifies that it provides the following four or more municipal services enumerated in Section 1, ORS 221.760;

- Police protection
- Fire protection
- Street construction and maintenance
- Sanitary sewers
- Storm sewers
- Planning, zoning and subdivision control
- Water system


**Section 2:** This resolution is and shall be effective from and after its passage by the City Council.
