- Structures constructed prior to Jan. 1, 2004 require an asbestos survey ([See DEQ Asbestos Survey Requirements](#))
- The owner of record is responsible for the removal & disconnection of the sewer & water supply or private sewage system.
- Private sewage disposal systems must be abandoned in accordance with the requirements of DEQ & the City of Portland.
- All debris from this demolition must be disposed of at an appropriate disposal site within five (5) days of the demolition.
- All private well systems must be disconnected, marked, and made safe from any potentially hazardous conditions.
- The Public Works Department of the City of Fairview **must** inspect sewer disconnections and remove water meters.
- The Contractor must request a pre-demo and then post-demo inspection(s).
- This permit application expires if a permit is not obtained within 180-days after it has been accepted as complete.
- Permits are non-transferable and expire 180-days from issuance or last inspection.
- If scope of work impacts the Right-of-Way (ROW) an approved ROW Permit is required. For County ROW contact Multnomah County Transportation 503-988-5050; for City ROW contact City of Fairview 503-665-9320.
