Fairview City Council Vacancy, Position 2– City Council Accepting Applications for Appointment

The Fairview City Council consists of a Mayor and six Councilors elected from the city at large. Council Position No. 2 is currently vacant.

Qualified residents may apply for the vacancy by submitting an application to fill the position. To qualify, candidates must be a qualified voter and have resided in the city for at least one year immediately preceding the appointment. Applications must be received by the Office of the City Recorder no later than 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, December 31, 2013.

Fairview City Council will conduct interviews of qualified candidates at the January 15, 2014 Fairview City Council meeting. The Council will make the appointment at a Council meeting after the interview process and the successful candidate will be sworn in immediately following.

The newly appointed Councilor will fill the term for Council Position No. 2 until December 31, 2014. The remainder of Council Position No. 2's term is subject to the November 2014 general election.
