Mr. Young's career includes 32 years as a city manager in three communities. His most recent service was as City Manager of The Dalles, from May 1997 to September 2015, a community with a population of over 14,000 residents. He holds a Master of Public Administration (MPA) from Brigham Young University Graduate School of Management. Mr. Young will begin his duties on Monday, January 25, 2016.

### Automatic Payment Option

The City now offers utility customers the option of enrolling in an automatic payment program. This voluntary program allows customers to sign up once and not have to worry about remembering to pay their utility bill. Payments will be deducted from enrolled customer accounts on the due date (the 15th of each month or the 15th of every other month for sewer-only customers).

**Utility Rate Increases Effective with January Billing**  
Utility rates are reviewed biennially to ensure adequate funding for maintenance and improvements of the utility systems.

Effective with the January billing, water, storm water, and wastewater rates increased 4.00%. The charge for a typical residential customer using 10 units of water will increase \$3.20 per month.
