3. REVIEW AND ADOPT MINUTES

Vice Chair Cooper moved to adopt the May 23, 2018 minutes and Member Uptergrove seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

Briefly reviewed the event. Overall felt the event went well. c. Art/Mural Project

Member Uptergrove will present the proposal at the July 18 Council meeting. CEC will promote the event at National Night Out and at Flicks in the Park. At Flicks on August 10 they will include a rock painting activity to build excitement for the project. The goal is to have the mural project on August 25.

Next Steps: Council presentation July 18; Member Uptergrove will research paint (donate/purchase); Councilor Cooper will contact the Recreation Manager to see about partnership options (ECR art instructors, NW art bus, etc.)


d. CEC Participation: Flicks in the Park & National Night Out


