Council Still Seeking Candidates

The Planning Commission is charged with the express duty of administering and enforcing the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Fairview. It is a seven member body appointed by the Fairview City Council. Position 6 is open with a term date of December, 31 2022 and Position 5 is open with a term date December 31, 2021.

The deadline to submit an application has been extended to Wednesday, August 12, 2020. Candidates must complete an interview to be considered for appointment. Council is scheduled to conduct candidate interviews August 19, 2020.
