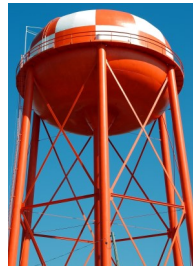
## Utility Rate Increases Effective with March Billing

Utility rates are reviewed biennially to ensure adequate funding for maintenance and improvements of the utility systems. The last review was deferred due to the COVID pandemic. The last water rate increase was in 2016 and the last storm water rate increase was in 2018.

After careful consideration, the Fairview City Council determined a rate adjustment to the City's water (4%) and storm water (9%), to take effect on March 1, 2022 and March 1, 2023, is essential to ensure adequate funding for these critical systems.

Effective with the March 2022 billing, the overall increase for a typical residential customer will be 2.79% or \$2.51 per month. Effective with the March 2023 billing, the overall increase will be 2.87% or \$2.66 per month for the typical residential customer.

## Reynolds School District is seeking community members to join the District Budget Committee!

The goal of the Budget Committee is to present a budget that ensures the district is planning to spend money in a responsible way that meets district goals. The Budget Committee reviews the proposed budget, listens to public comments, and suggests revisions to the budget, if needed. The committee then recommends the budget to the School Board for approval. The Budget Committee has two open positions to be filled by March 2022. Applicants must live and be registered to vote in the district, and may not be a district employee.

## Lead in Drinking Water

In mid - December the City mailed a brochure on "Lead in Drinking Water" to City of Fairview residents.

**To clarify, please note:** The City of Fairview **does not** have any lead in its source water, wells, water mains, or reservoirs. When water is in contact with pipes, service lines, and plumbing containing lead for several hours, the lead may enter drinking water. Homes built before 1988 are more likely to have lead pipes or lead solder.

For our residents who seek further reassurance, we have test kits available for pick up in Public Works at City Hall. The tests are conducted locally and cost \$30. The test kits include instructions on how to conduct the test and where to deliver the sample for processing.
