Mayor - 4 year term, currently held by Brian Cooper

Council Position 4 - 4 year term, currently held by Balwant Bhullar

Council Position 5 - 4 year term, currently held by Steve Owen

Council Position 6 - 4 year term, currently held by Darren Riordan

To qualify to be a candidate an elector shall have resided in the City of Fairview for a period of 12 months immediately preceding the City election.

The first day to file for candidacy with the City Recorder is June 1, 2022 and the last day to file is August 30, 2022 by 4:00 PM.
