

CITY OF FAIRVIEW CUSTOMER ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS

In an effort to provide support to our customers who are experiencing challenges paying their bills due to financial difficulties, the City of Fairview suggests the following options for potential assistance:

City of Fairview Payment Agreement: (503) 665-7929

Payment agreements are offered in certain circumstances to extend payment deadlines on City utility bills.

Human Services Oregon, 211 Info: (503) 222-5555

Provides referrals to organizations that may have funding available for residents of Multnomah County.

Albina Ministerial Alliances: (503) 285-0493

May have funds available for utility assistance for residents of Multnomah County.

Your Next Step: (503) 330-77585

May have funds available for temporary utility assistance of up to \$250 for Oregon residents.

St. Vincent DePaul Emergency Assistance Office: (503) 235-8431

Assistance may be available for Multnomah County residents (limited to \$100).

Salvation Army Cascade Division Veterans & Family Center: (503) 239-1259

Military personnel and/or dependents of deployed military personnel (including very recently returned) may be eligible for services.

Human Solutions: (503) 548-0217

Provides help to residents of Multnomah County for water, heat, and power assistance.

Multnomah Stability Initiative: (503) 988-4298

Has a list of providers who can help find emergency services such as utilities or housing.

MCAC-Mid Columbia Action Council: (541) 298-5131

Renters, homeless, and Veterans housing assistance.
