<b>Start Excavation:</b> Erosion control measures must be in place	
<b>Construction completed; soil not stabilized:</b> Erosion control measures must remain in place	
<b>Ground cover established:</b> Erosion control measures may be removed only after permanent site ground covers are in place	
EROSION CONTROL MAINTENANCE PLAN (ALL CONSTRUCTION)	
Maintenance measures required (check applicable measures):	
<b>Gravel construction entrance.</b> Maintain a minimum of 8 inches of gravel. <input type="checkbox"/>	
<b>Temporary sedimentation fence or alternate measures.</b> Inspect daily and clean sediment build-up daily prolonged rainfall and after each storm. <input type="checkbox"/>	
<b>Excavated materials (protect from erosion).</b> Inspect silt fence or alternate erosion control device and remove sediment build-up. <input type="checkbox"/>	
<b>Excavated materials covered during wet weather season.</b> Inspect plastic cover, or alternate, on excavated materials (November 1 – April 30) <input type="checkbox"/>

1. Building footprint and setbacks from the property line.
2. Public easements and rights-of-way with dimensions.
3. Silt fencing, particularly around areas bordering riparian zones.
4. Runoff direction.
